



Union Apprenticeship Application Announcement

IBEW Local 180 Electricians of Napa & Solano Counties are accepting applications in December and January!

1. Read the application announcement and requirements [on the JATC website \[http://www.jatclu180.org/\]](http://www.jatclu180.org/).
2. Get all required documents.
 - a. Copy of High School Diploma or GED*
 - b. Sealed high school transcript*
 - Request a sealed transcript from your high school and do not open the envelope.
 - Must have at least one year of high school algebra with a passing grade of “C” or better.
 - Accepted alternates: Sealed college transcript showing one semester of college algebra with a minimum “C” grade OR a certificate of completion from NJATC Tech Math online training course (more info on JATC website).
 - c. Copy of valid Driver’s License or Photo Identification
3. Optional documents:
 - a. Application form. May either print an [application from the JATC website \[http://www.jatclu180.org/?zone=/unionactive/view_article.cfm&HomeID=102722&page=Program20Information\]](http://www.jatclu180.org/?zone=/unionactive/view_article.cfm&HomeID=102722&page=Program20Information) and bring it, or come in on the application days and fill it out on-site.
 - b. If you are a veteran, register for free with a program called “Helmets to Hardhats”. Bring proof of registration when applying to receive “Priority Referral” to help your chance of entry into the apprenticeship program.
4. Go to training center to submit documents and fill out application.
 - a. DATE: December 6 - 10, 2021 & January 10 - 14, 2022
 - b. TIME: 1:00pm - 4:30pm
 - c. LOCATION: Solano-Napa JATC 720-A Technology Way Napa, CA 94558

*If your diploma and transcripts are from a different country (not USA) you will be required to have them reviewed (at your cost) by a recognized company that can interpret foreign educational programs to determine the education you have received is of an equivalent level to what is required by our program.
